

Marion Neil Woods, 77, of Burwell, Nebraska died September 8, 2015 at the Valley County Health System in Ord, Nebraska.

Funeral services will be at 10:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 12, 2015 at the Burwell Baptist Church in Burwell, Nebraska. Burial will be at the Cottonwood Cemetery in Burwell. Marion entered the United States Army on February 12, 1958. On March 1, 1964, Marion married Patricia Ballagh in Burwell. They lived in Costa Mesa, California where Marion worked in manufacturing for seven years. They then moved back to Garfield County where they farmed on the Woods home place. Marion delivered fuel for the Co-op until it closed, and then he worked for the Maverick Truckstop. Marion retired from farming and moved into town in 2002 and continued to work at the Maverick. He also mowed lawns and had a passion for cutting fire wood.

Marion was very competitive at cribbage, horse shoes, checkers and ping pong. After he was diagnosed with cancer his life was drastically changed. He began to enjoy coffee at Barb's Diner and the Senior Center, giving him a great place to practice the many jokes he liked to tell. Marion also enjoyed following his grandchildren's activities. When Marion was still farming, he was known for picking sweet corn and delivering it to the doorsteps of friends and family.
